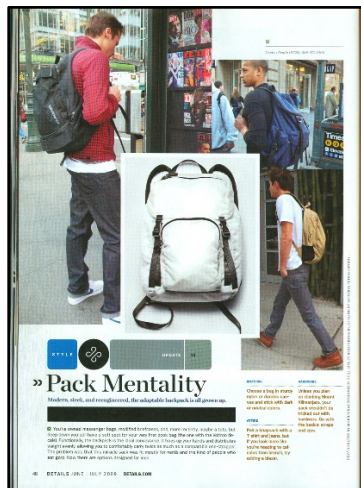
Headline Writing Magazine
