#### **Training Video**

## Coverage Hacks Used by Pro Staffs

#### **OBJECTIVE**

#### MATERIALS NEEDED

Students will build a repeatable story pipeline that moves club coverage from idea to finished spread through clear stages and weekly accountability.

- Shared live document or anchor chart paper
- Laptops or tablets
- Sticky notes or index cards (if working analog)
- · Whiteboards or wall space for a board

#### PART 1

#### WATCH THE TRAINING VIDEO

Play the training video "Club Coverage Hacks" independently, in groups or as a class.

#### PART 2

#### PRO COVERAGE PIPELINE INTRO

**Introduce the pro coverage pipeline stages as a class.** This can be documented visually in the classroom or digitally. For each club on campus, create the following columns:

- · Idea bank
- · Angle approved
- Interviews done
- · Photos gathered
- · Draft written
- · Edited and ready

#### PART 3

### **DEFINITIONS OF COMPLETION**

Talk with your staff about how to coverage is set and ready before diving in to spread design.

Example prompts include:

- "What counts as an approved angle?"
- "What makes an interview complete?"
- "How many photos is enough for a story?"

#### PART 4

#### PIPELINE BUILDING AND PUSH

#### As a staff:

- Build a shared story pipeline board either digitally or presented in the classroom. The columns should match the stages listed above.
- Students may add club cards (if using a visual board) or will to the digital doc. Each club will include:
  - Club name
  - Story angle
  - Assigned writer
  - First deadline

As a staff, determine how often you will run a coverage blitz to determine the progress of each club's coverage.
