- Make sure the items from your February checklist are complete.

 - Plan work nights for your staff so you can make your final deadline. Music and snacks are a must!

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Sales

 - Finalize ad billing and records of book sales.
 - Send out thank you notes to advertisers.
 - Begin planning your distribution party, where many last-minute sales will happen, and share the date with faculty.
